

# PRESCRIPTION ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

## WELVISTA:

- Cost: Free medications; \$20 non-refundable application fee.
- Eligibility:
  - Must be a South Carolina resident under age 65.
  - Must be uninsured (no Medicaid, Medicare, VA, ACA, or private insurance).
  - Household income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.
- Benefits: Over 300 medications for chronic and acute conditions mailed directly to your home.
- Application: Takes 2–3 weeks to process. Must reapply annually.

## SOUTH CAROLINA DRUG CARD:

- Cost: Free
- Eligibility:
  - Open to all South Carolina residents, including those with insurance (for non-covered medications)
- Benefits: Discounts up to 80% on prescriptions
- How to use: No enrollment required. You can print a pre-activated card from [southcarolinadrugcard.com](https://southcarolinadrugcard.com)
- Accepted at: CVS, Walgreens, Target, and others

## SOUTH CAROLINA THRIVE:

- Services: Helps residents apply for Medicaid, Medicare Savings Programs, Welvista, and other healthcare assistance.
- Support: Offers screening, application help, and guidance through their Thrive Hub
